PALM SUNDAY

Jesus as well as the people knew of the opposition of the authorities and yet Jesus moved without fear of hiding. On Sunday morning of Passover Week, when pilgrims were traveling to Jerusalem, Our Lord went openly from Bethany to Jerusalem, by the most direct road. He even sent His disciples in for a donkey, thus encouraging a celebration. The enthusiastic followers made a triumphal procession, and in triumph Our Lord entered the Holy City. As He saw the Temple and the city spread out before Him, Our Lord predicted its destruction and wept over the city. This triumphal procession was the greatest length to which Our Lord permitted His Messianic Kingdom to be proclaimed.



Great excitement prevailed in the city upon His arrival. Toward the end of the day He predicted His death by being "lifted up from the earth," and told the people: "Yet a little while the light is among you. Walk while you have the light, that darkness may not overtake you." It was the twilight of the Light of the World. At dusk Our Lord returned with His disciples to Bethany.
